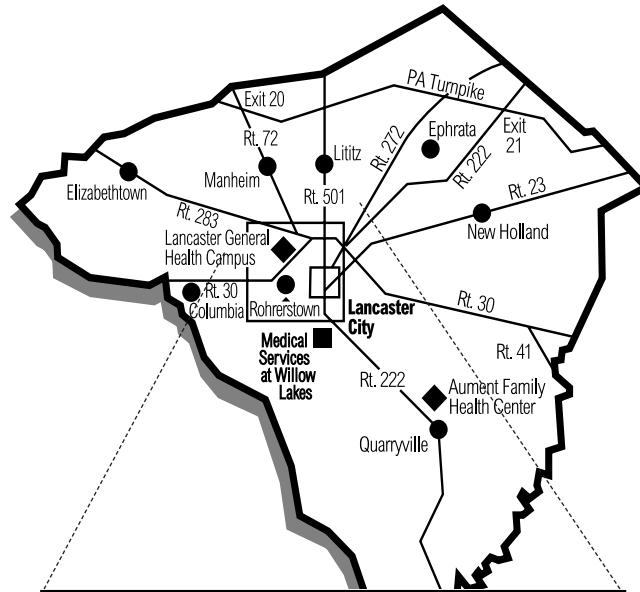

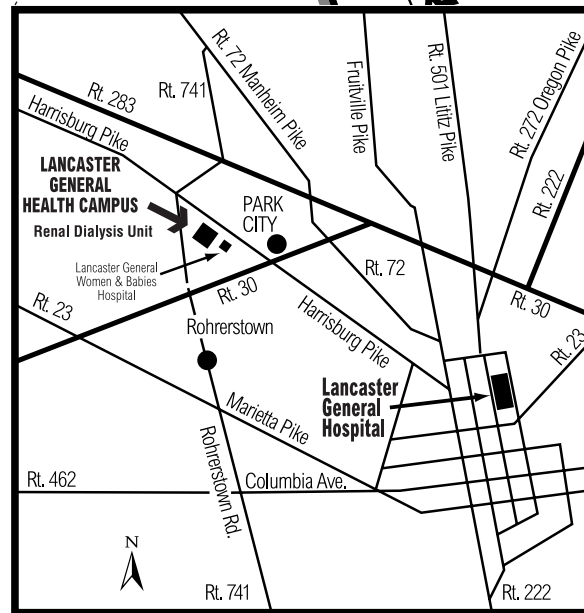

Welcome to the Renal Dialysis Unit at Lancaster General Health Campus. Our 32-station, state-of-the-art unit has been specially designed and professionally staffed to meet the unique needs of those with chronic kidney disease. A peritoneal dialysis training area is available for patients interested in home dialysis.

Waiting Area

Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled treatment time. To assure your safety, we ask that you remain in the waiting area until called by staff.

While you wait, please enjoy television, magazines and a variety of educational materials.

Visitors

Social support is an important element of our patients' care and well-being. One visitor over the age of 12 may sit with you during your treatment.

Visitors are asked to remain in the waiting area until all patients within a treatment area are "put on" their machines. Visitors will be asked to return to the waiting area when patients are being "taken-off" their machines.

Food

Food is available in **Today's Taste Café** from 7 am-2:30 pm.

Vending machines are located in the café and are accessible whenever the Health Campus is open.

A **coffee bar** (Evelyn's Corner), located in the main lobby, is open from 7 am-4:30 pm.

Education and Wellness

The Education and Wellness Center is located on the second floor of the Health Campus, just off the main lobby elevators. Books, videos and audio-tapes are available for you to borrow.

A wellness cart is brought into the Dialysis Unit on a daily basis to assist with your selections.

Transportation and Phone

Red Rose Transit Authority provides transportation to the Health Campus. Bus schedules are available in the main lobby. Individuals unable to ride the bus may use Red Rose Access. Please see one of the social workers to apply for this service.

Phone calls can be made from the front desk in the waiting area. One phone is for local calls only. A second phone is a direct line to Red Rose Access transportation services and Friendly Taxi. From home, Red Rose Access may be reached at 291-1243 and Friendly Taxi at 393-2222.

Campus Parking

Handicapped spaces are available. If you need assistance to and from your car, please see the staff at the main lobby desk. Family members are permitted to drop off patients at the main entrance.

Wheelchairs

Wheelchairs are available if needed and can be found in the main lobby to the left of the entrance.

Other Services
